



August 2024 Progress Report for Sarothak Global Resource Centre (SGRC)

In August, SGRC continued its commitment to promoting inclusion and skill development with several noteworthy achievements.

Vision in the Dark sessions remained impactful, with two sessions held this month. Participants lauded these experiences as transformative, deepening their understanding of the challenges faced by the visually impaired and enhancing empathy and awareness.

The **Employment Center** saw significant progress, securing seven job placements through new partnerships with organizations like Carrier and PolicyBazaar.com. Key activities included Business Process Optimization and Disability Understanding Training, further strengthening our efforts to enhance recruitment inclusivity.

At the **Skill Development Center**, 21 training sessions were conducted for 174 attendees. Topics covered included effective time management, leadership skills, and pre-employment preparation. This comprehensive training continues to equip individuals with essential skills for the job market.

The **Early Intervention and Rehabilitation Center** provided ongoing therapies to 196 individuals, including three new enrollments. Activities focused on daily living skills and motor therapy, significantly benefiting the participants' development.

Visitor feedback this month highlighted the continued success of our programs, with many praising the "Vision in the Dark" experience and the overall impact of SGRC's initiatives on promoting disability inclusion.
