Empowering Through Skills and Employment

- Skill Programs: Over 5000+ PwD beneficiaries are enrolled in our training programs
 across various centers (2300 in JEET & 2700 in DL). This month, Ms. Ruchi Khemka,
 CSR Head, Deutsche Bank, visited our Sarthak Jaipur Center, and we hosted a
 medical camp at our Guwahati Center in collaboration with Jubilant Food Works
 Foundation.
- Employment Success: In June, we facilitated employment for over 190+ trainees.
 Notable placements include Aniruddha Singh Dangi at TVS Motors, Janapareddy Naidu at Accenture, Mamatha Bai at Reliance Jio, and Vani M at ZF Commercial Vehicles.



Digital Platforms Making an Impact

Sarthak continues to expand its digital outreach through platforms like <u>CapSarathi</u>, <u>RozgarSarathi</u>, and <u>GyanSarathi</u>. CapSarathi saw 2088 users in June with 2117 profiles completed and 25 NGO partners. GyanSarathi registered 1740 candidates, enrolled 703 in 20 batches, and saw 755 completing training. RozgarSarathi registered 1885 job seekers and 71 employers, with 255 job postings and 948 applications.

Building Stronger Partnerships

- Collaborative Efforts: We were delighted to host visits from Bry-Air, LIC Housing
 Finance, and Dr. Yogesh Dubey from Mumbai University at our Sarthak Global
 Resource Centre. Our Guwahati Center collaborated with Jubilant Bhartia Foundation
 to organize a Medical Health Camp for our PwD trainees.
- Support from TaskUs: TaskUs has supported 91 beneficiaries through our flagship program JEET.

Innovations at Sarthak Global Resource Center

In June, we received 109 visits at SGRC, with 27 people experiencing the Vision in the Dark and Ability Museum. New partnerships with corporate entities like Club Mahindra, KFC, and Tata Teleservices are underway. Programs like B-PORT, DUIT, and EETs are gaining momentum.




Advancing Early Intervention
