

# Sarthak Spotlight: Monthly Newsletter – September 2024

### **Skill Programs**

In September 2024, Sarthak's skill programs continued to empower individuals with disabilities across India, with 9,872+ PwD beneficiaries enrolled in various training initiatives. This includes 4,579 participan in JEET and 5,293 in Digital Literacy programs.

# **Employment Programs**

Our employment initiatives saw substantial progress this month, facilitating employment for over 250+ trainees across sectors like retail, hospitality, IT, and more. Sarthak conducted multiple interview drives w companies including Vivanta Hotels, Godrej Properties, The Westin Hotels, D-Mart, BPCL, Hilton Hotels, and Tatwa Technologies.

- Rohit Murlidhar Kolte (Hearing Disability) secured a position as a Warehouse Executive at Flipkart witl salary of INR 18,000 per month.
- Balwinder Singh (Hearing Disability) placed at BPCL as Supporting Staff with INR 13,000 per month.

#### **Sarthak Global Resource Center (SGRC)**



#### **Early Intervention (EI) Program**

Our partnership with IDFC boosted our EI efforts, delivering online sessions across seven centers. The program focused on home-based activity videos and hosted a parents' meet with Dr. Suman Aggarwal.







#### **NAAI** and IDEA

NAAI continued online training in 12 skill categories. Registration for the East and South Zone Regional Abilympics Skill Competitions is ongoing.

IDEA welcomed 24 new NGO partners and hosted a one-day Capacity Building Workshop for Early Intervention NGO partners at SGRC.

## RozgarSarathi, CapSarathi, GyanSarathi Updates

**CapSarathi:** 4,076 users engaged, 2,487 profiles completed, 31 NGO partners onboarded, and 385 user enrolled in training.

**GyanSarathi:** 2,053 candidates registered, 646 learners actively enrolled, and 611 successfully complete their training.

**RozgarSarathi:** 1,710 job seekers and 20 employers registered, 131 jobs posted, and 90 applicants successfully placed.
