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

Arya – Sarthak Early Intervention Center

When we started with the Early Intervention program, our thought was simple -Instead of helping them overcome their disabilities let's try to help them maximize their abilities.

Today, several kids with special needs are a part of our family. Sharing the story of another beautiful child —Arya. Arya is 5year-old girl with hearing impairment. Her family was overwhelmed as they welcomed their bundle of joy until they noticed something unusual.

Her parents detected that she did not respond to sounds on name-calling at the age of 8 months. This intrigued them and they went for BERA.

There, she was diagnosed with Hearing Impairment. Nobody would expect something like that when the baby looked perfectly alright!! This was obviously the most disturbing news for them as parents.

However, they shook the sorrow off their shoulders soon and started to look for solutions to comfort their baby and to make her life normal as other kids.

She used hearing aids at the age of 2 years but did not get any response from hearing aids too. Then they went for Cochlear Implant at the age 4 years. But post that too, the child was not able to hear any sound, could not respond to words, and did not follow verbal commands. She only used and understand gestures. When somebody told them about Sarthak, they found a ray of hope.

They consulted with Sarthak Early Intervention team of professionals, who suggested speech therapy and special education. She could understand visual cues and takes help of her special educators.

After continuous online sessions both telephonic as well as online, her auditory skills and speech started improving.

Currently, Arya is able to stay attentive during activities. She can respond with words when asked from behind. She can understand simple questions and answers verbally. She can count numbers 1-20, and identify and name common animals, vegetables and fruits. She can greet by saying namaste. Her both receptive & expressive vocabulary have also improved.

Parents are happy to see her change. Now she asks for her needs verbally. They are thankful to Sarthak for their constant support and guidance.





For Atharv's family, Sarthak has become a home away from home, a place where he found love and support. The family looks forward to continued support and growth in their child's development journey with Sarthak and we can't be happier growing as we see him growing and glowing every day.

Atharv is a 4 years old child. Although, he was born as a full-term baby & his birth weight was age-appropriate too, his mother recalls that his birth cry was delayed and as he grew up, developmental milestones were also found to be delayed.

The family reported this to the doctor and Atharv was diagnosed with Down syndrome.

Down's syndrome is a genetic disorder caused when abnormal cell division results in extra pair of chromosome. Down's syndrome causes intellectual disability and developmental delays and also distinct facial appearances.

Initially, His parents didn't understand how they would tackle this challenge and help their child lead a normal life. They took the doctor's advice who suggested multiple therapies that were expensive. And, the family didn't know, where to get help from. Atharv's mother felt miserable as the child wouldn't respond to her voice and didn't mix up with other kids of his age. Soon, with the help of our mobilization team, Atharv's mother got associated with Sarthak, and he was enrolled for therapies after taking a detailed case history.

The therapist at the centre noted chief complaints according to his parents such as lack of attention, difficulty in speaking, and holding things in hand & inability to walk properly.

After evaluation, Atharv was enrolled for Speech & Occupational Therapy and special education. Due to COVID-19, online sessions are being conducted and regular follow-ups are done to train his mother regarding activities. Gradually with telephonic and online sessions, now the child has started improving and currently, his attention skill is slightly improved, also improved sitting span is another development. The child is able to pick and hold toys in hand and tries to communicate.

Atharv's parents are happy that the child started learning new things, enjoys being himself and has fun with other kids.

Early Intervention at Sarthak Children with special needs

Early Intervention Services are special services for infants and toddlers at risk for developmental delays. These services are designed to identify and meet children's needs in five developmental areas. These are physical, cognitive, communication, social or emotional development, sensory and adaptive development.

Early intervention focuses on helping eligible babies and toddlers learn the basic and brand-new skills that typically develop during the first three years of life.

Know Our Early Intervention Team -

- To prevent developmental delay and disability.
- Psychologist To counsel, conduct comprehensive assessment & Recommend therapies
- Occupational Therapist To improve fine & gross motor skills.
- Speech Therapist To improve speech & language skills
- **Special Educator** Concept building using Teaching Learning Materials (TLM)

Kids Activities at the Centre

Activities are organized with the objective -

- To Maximize the child's residual capacity, social skills and encourage participation.
- To increase the involvement of the child with other children that enhance the child's development

Activities such as- At & craft, Games, Socialization & Recreational activities, Festival celebrations etc are carried out to encourage kids to participate in different things.
